1924
St. Francis Hospital opens to serve Port Jervis and surrounding communities.

1940s
St. Francis Hospital treats a variety of medical conditions ranging from diagnostic and surgical services to emergency care and maternity.

1950s/1960s
St. Francis Hospital expands with new addition including a wide variety of new services.

1970s
St. Francis Hospital becomes Mercy Community Hospital. Cardinal Frances Spellman dedicates the new east wing addition.

2000s
Bon Secours Charity Health System acquires Mercy Community Hospital and it is renamed Bon Secours Community Hospital.

2010s
Bon Secours Community Hospital joins WMCHealth Network.
\$25 Million New York State grant announced to launch Medical Village project.
Cardinal Timothy Dolan dedicates the temporary emergency department.

2020s
Bon Secours Community Hospital's new 10,000 square foot Emergency Department opens.
500th COVID discharge.
